

# Three Keys to a Successful Infrastructure Project in Residential Neighborhoods

(Track A) 0.75 credit The Swann Street neighborhood, located in the City of Raleigh, NC, experienced frequent structural and street flooding and did not meet the City's desired 10-year Level of Service (LOS). 
