

## SESWA Community Forum Help Guide

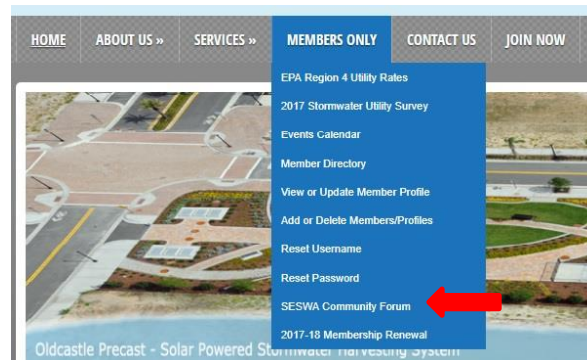
The SESWA Community Forum is an easy way for members to connect and ask questions to other stormwater professionals throughout the Southeast.

### Accessing the SESWA Community Forum

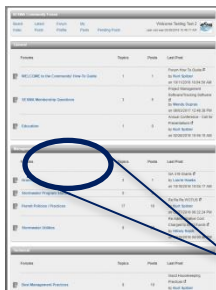
