Attendees will learn how to identify and solve issues surrounding poor maintenance, as well as avoid GI failures entirely. This course was prepared for stormwater managers, stormwater engineers and consultants, MS4 Inspectors and maintenance crews.

Upon completion, trainees will have learned to:

- Implement correct construction sequencing protocol for BMPs
- Understand how to read a BMP landscape plan
- Identify soil mixtures and calculate soil / material volumes
- Identify and select appropriate plants for BMPs
- Understand maintenance requirements of BMPs
- Identify common problems and solutions for BMPs
- Understand how to implement a landscape maintenance plan
- Evaluate plant performance and how to replace failing plants
