In-house Inspection program

- Reactive Work
  - Customer Complaint
  - Higher Priority (usually)
- Proactive Work
  - Inspections and Asset Management
  - Lower Priority (usually)



Inspector or Investigator Creates a Work Order

- Logs Details
- Preliminary Priority





Management Review of Work Orders


Confirm priority

• Hazards deemed 'High" or 'Emergency'

• Active is sues are 'Medium'

• Little stuff is "Low"





Cleaning Needed: Low Priority



Cracked d/w from customer complaint: Medium Priority





Failed d/w Pipe: High Priority




Potential Hazard: Emergency



Assigning and Tracking Work

Setting goals

• Red/Green Report





Follow industry standards

• 80% wrench time out of total hours

• Complete 60% of work within that 80% wrench time

- Mix of tasks and priorities
- Projects that eat up a lot of time
- Restoration after County crew work
